ONE DAY EXCURSION

Come and enjoy the nature, culture and traditions of a colorful port inhabited by fishermen. This place is called “Puerto El Morro”, and is located at the Guayas province’s Gulf, southwest of Ecuador.

DESCRIPTION



We'll depart at 07h30am from Guayaquil towards Puerto El Morro by private bus. Once in the place we will take a boat ride to the “Birds Island” –*approximate travel time: 1 hour each way*. We will enjoy the system of mangroves in which is possible to see the Magnificent frigatebird, the roseate spoonbill, the Peruvian booby, pelicans, probably blue-footed bobbies, as well as many other mangrove birds. We could even spot Delta Dolphins (*Bottlenose Dolphin*). You may explore further more and have some relaxing before it's time to re-board and ride back to the Port.
